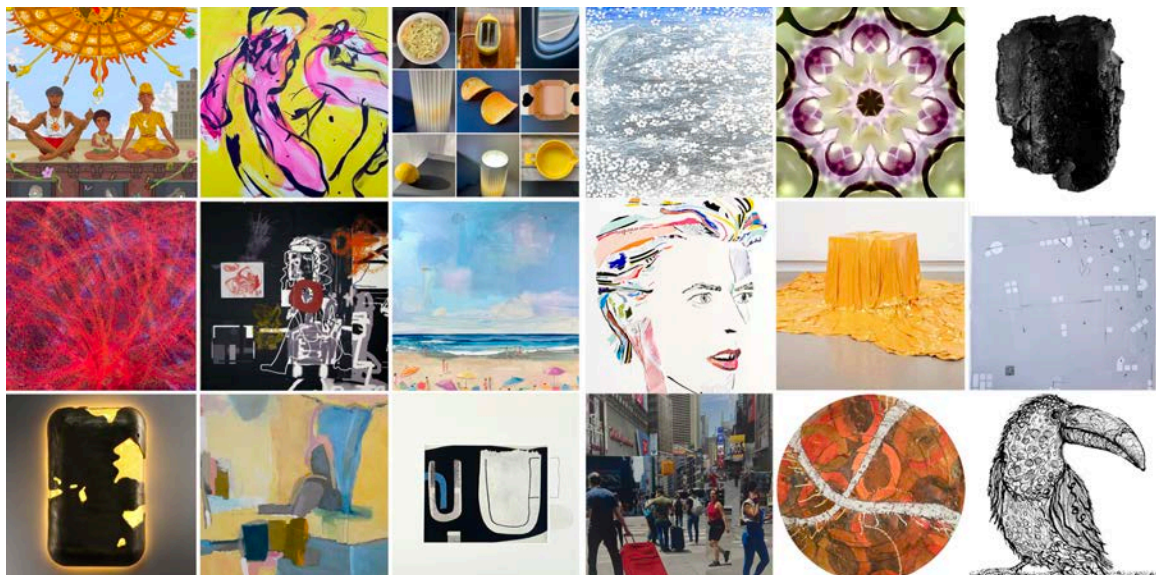

What: On October 22nd and October 23rd the High Line Open Studios will re-open since the pandemic shut down. Over 70 artists in more than 13 buildings in the West Chelsea art gallery district will invite the public to tour their private studios.

The two-day weekend event attracts art enthusiasts, collectors, curators, artists, and tourists to the neighborhood making it a community-wide celebration.
